



## CITY&GUILDS NPTC LEVEL 3 AWARDS IN CONTROLLING RISKS TO HEALTH & SAFETY IN CEMETERIES AND CREMATORIA

The ICCM has always been committed to bringing accredited, valued, nationally recognised and relevant training and qualifications from industry professionals to industry professionals. As part of this commitment we are delighted to announce two new qualifications which will be delivered and assessed by City&Guilds NPTC trained and qualified instructors.

The two new Level 3 Awards are designed specifically for those who are employed in the industry who have responsibility for the ongoing safety of anyone who uses either cemeteries or crematoria, whether in management, supervisory, Health & Safety, union officials or those looking for further CPD. On successful completion of the qualification learners will know

the difference between hazard and risk, be able to complete task specific risk assessments appropriate to either cemeteries or crematoria, know control measures, how to inform those who may be affected, instruct others, know sources of guidance. Learners will understand how purchasing decisions can reduce risks. During the three day courses candidates will observe either the processes carried out in safe burial practice or in cremation, learners will be assessed for the first units through observation, question and answer sessions or through hands on demonstration.

Unit 2 is a work based assignment, which learners have a month to submit, building on the knowledge learnt during the three day training course.

Active participation by learners is encouraged throughout, with learners benefitting from different or shared experiences on the first course run recently.

Courses will be held throughout the year. Cemetery courses can be held at your site or at Berkshire College of Agriculture, Crematorium courses can be held at your site or at regional centres; details on the website
