

An invitation from West Suffolk Crematorium

West Suffolk Crematorium was built in 1989 and is set in 13 acres of countryside near the village of Risby, just outside the market town of Bury St Edmunds serving communities from there to Ipswich, Thetford to Diss and Newmarket to Cambridge. Part of the Westerleigh Group, they currently carry out just over 2,000 cremations per year, and around 20 interments in the cemetery which offers traditional burial and a smaller woodland area option.
