Treatment of an Institute Member - Mrs Angela Dunn FICCM(Dip)

I am most saddened by the Institute's appalling treatment of a fellow member as detailed in the Board of Directors' May newsletter. Those familiar with Institute policies, particularly those relating to the management of memorials and the treatment of non-viable foetal remains, will be aware of the highly valued work carried out by Mrs Dunn on our behalf - much of which was completed over many years in a voluntary capacity.

By the Board's own admission, Mrs Dunn, who is a Fellow and Past President of the Institute, was subject to unlawful victimisation, discrimination and constructive unfair dismissal when "*...there was no basis to call into question the conduct of Angela Dunn*". Whilst the Board has reached a settlement in this matter, members have a right to be informed about the persons who have been or will be held accountable for the mistreatment of an Institute member. Those responsible for such unacceptable conduct have brought our Institute into disrepute and must be brought to account. Further failure by the Board in this matter would compound the mismanagement evident to date. I believe that the members and each Branch will want action and answers.
