Redditch Crematorium, which was opened in 1973, is located on top of a hill overlooking the Arrow Valley Park. Situated next to the historic site of Bordesley Abbey, the chapel was designed to make the most of the magnificent views over the surrounding Worcestershire countryside.

The building has been designed to fit into its natural setting and in its construction uses many natural materials such as Welsh grey slate, copper, cedar and pine wood. The lofty and spacious chapel is of simple design to complement the natural views.
