



PUBLIC HEALTH ACT FUNERALS TRAINING COURSE

A unique half-day training course delivered by qualified and experienced ICCM Officers, aimed at those who make funeral arrangements under Section 46 of the Public Health (Control of Disease) Act 1984.

The course will examine all aspects of arranging funerals under the Public Health Act, including developing an appropriate policy, case referrals, investigations and conducting property searches, contacting next of kin, dealing with the deceased's estate and ensuring the authority recovers costs wherever possible. Those attending will receive a copy of the ICCM Guidance on Public Health Act Funerals.
