

Sexton Duties Course

This course has been designed to enable your authority in providing a trouble free funeral service. The course is useful for managers, gravediggers and cemetery admin and operational staff who combine to ensure a sensitive and trouble free service. The course covers the legal aspects relating to the Local Authorities Cemeteries Order 1977 and current health and safety legislation as well as the customer care considerations in respect the grave digging process and both the chapel and committal services.

The course familiarises candidates with common problem scenarios and how these can be solved in a lawful manner thus protecting the bereaved and the authority. Good checking procedures are discussed in order to prevent error such as burial in the wrong grave, shallow depth of burial and ensuring correct dimension of graves to ensure safe passage of coffins.

Candidates are also familiarised with the various forms of disposal certificate and the need for correct authority required before burial can take place. The overall aims of the course are reproduced on the next page.

A training course will take place on <u>Wednesday</u>, 13th May 20 at Enable Leisure & Culture, Conference Room, Staff Yard, Battersea Park, SW11 4NJ.
