This donation will enable us to work with our partners Nottingham City Council in order to provide a number of enhancements to benefit wildlife at cemeteries in the city, especially at Wilford Hill.

I have already met with Cemeteries and Crematorium Manager, Dave Stretton, and Mark Peel and Rob Busby in connection with the project.
