Fixed costs are significant for our industry and include grounds maintenance, waste disposal, building heating and maintenance, plant maintenance and office facilities.

The BCET scheme considers all of these factors with the potential to reduce costs, not just for one year, but perpetually.

The BCET scheme aims to create a new culture; one that reduces fixed costs, addresses global warming and enables benchmarking with other authorities.



Variable costs associated with levels of business generated may also be influenced.

Savings made by using fewer cremators over longer periods are now irrefutable.
