



Diploma Study Days

What are the Diploma Study Days?

The Diploma Study Days are being held to give students the opportunity to complete assignments in the core Diploma units of Cemetery Management, Crematorium Management and Cemetery and Crematorium Law.

The focus will be very much on completing assignments ahead of the August deadline, when Pearson withdraw their accreditation of the Diploma. The Diploma will still exist after this date, but it won't be accredited to HNC standard. Alternative accreditation options are currently being considered. Any work already undertaken won't be wasted, and will be counted towards any new accreditation in the future.

When and where are the Diploma Study Days?

The Diploma Study Days are being held on **Tuesday 13th and Wednesday 14th June 2023** at the Kents Hill Park Training and Conference Centre, Swallow House, Kents Hill Park, Milton Keynes, MK7 6BZ.

What happens at the Seminar?

The Study Days will purely focus on working on assignments relating to Cemetery Management, Crematorium Management, and Cemetery and Crematorium Law. Tutors will be on hand to provide guidance and to mark drafts. Students will be able to work in small groups to complete their assignments. Students will need to bring their own laptop computer (Wi-Fi internet access is provided), and any workbooks, notes etc that they will need.

Each day will start at 09.30. Refreshments and lunch are provided.

In the evening, attendees can opt to eat at the venue, or can make their own arrangements. Accommodation is also available at the venue at a preferential rate, or attendees can make alternative arrangements if they choose.

Is this different to the Education Seminar?

Yes. There are no exhibitors present and no social events in the evening. The Study Days are held over two days from 09.30 until approximately 17.30. Refreshments and lunch are provided, but no evening meals. Accommodation is not included, but can be booked directly with the venue, or alternative provider.

The focus will be on assisting students to complete their core Diploma modules.
